Club Staff:	Full-time site coordinator, program manager, youth development specialist and
	membership secretary. Part-time tutors, art instructor, and youth development
	specialists.
Membership:	\$25 annual membership fee and monthly childcare fee based on family household
	income using a sliding fee scale.
Member Benefits:	Vision and dental services, tutoring, field trips, character and leadership development,
	community service, sports & recreation, and more.
Transportation:	BGC provides one-way transportation from Halls Ferry to Lee Hamilton Elementary
	School Club, Monday – Friday in the afternoon only.
Meals/Snacks:	A vendor provides and serves a hot meal and snack daily during the school year and
	breakfast, lunch, and a snack in the summer.
Academic Support:	Tutors are certified teachers or have degrees in math, science and/or language arts.
	Members are required to participate in Power Hour, a homework assistance and
	academic enrichment program that includes high yield learning activities. They must
	also
	engage in STRIDE Academy, a web-based adaptive learning program aligned with
	Missouri Common Core Standards, 90-minutes weekly.
Mentoring:	Twenty-four members paired with either a club staff or an approved volunteer mentor
	meet at least once weekly for an hour using National Boys & Girls Clubs of
	America curricula such as Passport to Manhood, SMART Moves, Project Learn/Power
	Hour.
